FY 2014 Action Plan & Pre-adoption Public Hearing
Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

The City of Coconut Creek is an entitlement recipient of federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, and anticipates receiving an estimated \$258,962 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2014-2015 funds to address community development and housing needs in Coconut Creek. In order to receive these funds, the City must develop and adopt a One-Year Action Plan that is consistent with the City's 2013-2017 Consolidated Plan. The Consolidated Plan and Action Plan were developed consistent with the City's approved Citizen Participation Plan.

ACTION PLAN SUMMARY:

The proposed FY 2014-2015 Action Plan describes the proposed use of funds and how these projects/activities will help achieve the overall goal and objectives outlined in the City of Coconut Creek's Consolidated Plan for Federal Funds for 2013-2017.

Project/Activity	Proposed
1. S.O.S Children's Village. – This activity will provide roof repair/replacement assistance to S.O.S Children's Village. This assistance is eligible under 24 CFR section 570.201(c) public facilities and will directly benefit low and moderate income persons as qualified under 570.208 (a)(2) limited clientele.	\$168,326
2. Youth Summer Camp Scholarship Program – This activity is scheduled to provide assistance to low-to-moderate income youth to participate in the City's summer camp recreational program. This activity is eligible under 24 CFR section 570.201 (e) public services and will directly benefit low and moderate income persons as qualified under 570.208 (a) (2) limited clientele.	\$38,844
3. Planning and Administration – This activity will provide for administrative and planning duties relative to the overall grant program. This activity is assumed to benefit low and moderate income persons and is eligible under 24 CFR Section 570.206.	\$51,792
FY 2014 TOTAL	\$258,962

All of the activities identified above will principally benefit lower income residents of the City of Coconut Creek and no displacement or relocation of Coconut Creek residents or businesses is anticipated.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Prior to adoption, the City of Coconut Creek will hold a public hearing on the proposed FY 2014-2015 Action Plan on July 10, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. in the Commission Chambers at City Hall located at 4800 West Copans Road, Coconut Creek, FL 33063. Interested parties are encouraged to attend and participate.
