May 6th, 2018

The City of Pembroke Pines announces the availability of funding in the amount of approximately **\$1,000,000.00** in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) & Home Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), and approximately **\$700,000.00** in State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) for Housing Rehabilitation, and funding in the amount of approximately **\$160,000.00** in State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) for Purchase Assistance. These funds will be used for the City of Pembroke Pines housing initiatives for very low, low, and moderate income households, with priority given to special needs households. Applications will be processed on a first come, first qualified, first served basis in the order applications are received for the programs listed below until funds are encumbered.

The amount of assistance per household will vary with income level. Priority will be given to households with special needs.	\$160,000.00

Minor Home Repair Program - Provides assistance to approximately 35 households to correct code violations, make barrier-free modifications, install hurricane protection, address weatherization improvements, promote energy efficiency/conservation and address other minor home repairs to owner-occupied properties in the City. Available to extremely low, very low, and moderate income households. Priority given to very low and low income households, and households with special needs.	\$1,700,000.00
