The City of Pembroke Pines is an entitlement recipient of federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). The City has received an additional allocation of funds (CARES Act) to combat COVID-19. In order to receive these funds, the City must adopt a One-Year Action Plan that is consistent with its 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan for Housing and Community Development Programs. The following amends the previously approved Action Plans. The amendment is summarized below.
